Integrating this global expertise into our work and at the same time acting as an intermediary between Europe and Japan will deliver valuable returns for both sides," welcomes Ralf Diemer, CEO of the eFuel Alliance, the future cooperation.

With Suzuki's accession, the Alliance, which has almost 180 members, now has its eighth Japanese member. The entire membership structure spans four continents, 17 countries and the entire eFuels value chain. The further internationalization of the eFuel Alliance pursues the goal of supporting the expansion of renewable energies, global climate protection efforts and worldwide potential for the production of climate-friendly fuels.

"While European efforts to ramp up the market for climate-neutral fuels remain cautious, these solutions are becoming increasingly relevant and attractive in Asia," Diemer emphasizes. "At the same time, countries such as Japan in particular are looking at European legislation and taking their lead from our developments. Considering the need to strengthen our domestic economy and our role model function, a clear focus on open-technology approaches is needed in view of the upcoming European elections."
